Covid Update from Ministry of Health Site

You should minimise contact with others in your household while you wait for the test result. Others in your house only need to self-isolate while you wait for results if you have symptoms and are a close or casual contact of a confirmed or (probable) case of COVID-19.


















School Based Immunisation Programme 2021 – Yr 8 Students

The West Coast DHB is once again offering a School Based Immunisation programme to Yr 8 students. This includes HPV, plus the option of having their 11-year vaccination if they have not vet received it at their GP.

The Consent Form has been sent home.

Whether you choose to accept or decline
the offer please return the form to school promptly.

Protect your child against serious diseases

If your child is aged 11 or 12, they will be offered free immunisations at school to help protect them against serious diseases such as diphtheria, tetanus, whooping cough and most HPV cancers.

Your child will bring home a Parent Consent Form which has more information. To make sure your child receives their school immunisations, remember to sign and return the consent form to school.
